Health, safety and nutritional needs are just three of the issues Child Care Health Consultants help improve in Lincoln and Gaston child care facilities. Health Consultant, Christine Rosinski, loves working with children and noted, "my background is in pediatrics and working with children, seeing that they receive all the benefits they need to succeed, makes my job very rewarding." The Health Consultant's job is a critical component to child care centers and homes to ensure model policies are being implemented as well as provide technical assistance and training to facilities. As a Health Consultant she responds to all requested trainings and visitations to all the licensed child care centers, family care homes and NC Pre-K sites in Gaston County. Through on-site consultations, consultations by phone and professional trainings/workshops, she is prepared to offer insight for important topics such as sudden infant death syndrome, emergency preparedness, oral health and handwashing.

Trainings are provided free of charge for the child care centers/homes. They help implement state-recommended health and safety policies and ensure that teaching staff implement them on a daily basis. This program is administered by the Gaston County Department of Health & Human Services and is funded by the Partnership.

There are many trainings available to child care centers and homes such as communicable diseases and immunizations, diapering procedures/sanitation, head lice or breastfeeding friendly childcare.
