

Tiffany and Tim Taylor have nothing but good things to say about the NC Pre-K program in Lincoln County. Their twins, Hope and Bryan went through the program and the results are evident they said. "They are both really advanced in reading and writing," said Father, Tim. Mom Tiffany agrees. "They knew their ABC's, letters and colors," she said. "They went above and beyond."

The couple wanted to prepare their children for kindergarten and chose the NC Pre-K program to do this. Tiffany said she boasts about the program all the time and wants everyone to know how much it has helped their children with computer, math and reading skills. Hope and Bryan are now 7-years-old and have just started first grade at Lincoln Charter School.

The North Carolina Pre-Kindergarten (NC Pre-K) program is a state-funded, community-based pre-kindergarten program designed to provide 4-year-old children with a valuable educational experience. The Partnership for Children of Lincoln & Gaston Counties serves as the NC Pre-K contract administrator for Lincoln County.

There are NC Pre-K classrooms located in the following facilities:

• Mini Academy @ Denver • Ms. Em's Child Development Center • A Place to Grow • G E Massey Elementary Pre-K • Lincoln Park Head Start • Norris S. Childers Elementary Pre-K • North Brook Elementary Pre-K

NC Pre-K is limited to children who were four years old on or before August 31, 2014. Eligibility for NC Pre-K is determined by a number of criteria, including family size, gross income, and developmental needs or other risk factors. Applications for Lincoln County's NC Pre-K can be obtained at any of Lincoln County's NC Pre-K's classroom sites, the office of Lincoln County Schools, and on the Partnership's website at www.pfclg.com under the Programs tab. Applications are also available at the office of the Partnership for Children. Please submit completed applications to the Partnership office.
